I must apologise for not replying to your earlier letter sooner but I have been away visiting my daughter overseas and did not have time to write before I left. The cheque was, however, deposited, and should have gone through your bank by now, as should the second. What we have done is credit you with a second year's subscription for the second cheque. I hope that suits you.

My daughter lives in England so I have just had the opportunity to see for myself how right you are about the progress that has been made by black people there, including now, of course, entry into Parliament itself. That, of course, is what we need here.... a system which allows every person to have the same say as every other in the election of Parliament. The problem is how to overcome the great white fear that once political control passes out of their hands it will be used against them in the same way as they have used it against blacks for all these years.
