Thank you for your letter of June 27th.

I am sorry I have been rather slow about replying to it but I was away when it arrived.

We do offer a discount of one-third to booksellers and we do have back numbers of the 1988 numberz. In fact there have only been two, March/May having been combined into a special double issue devoted largely to articles on local government. The July number, another special issue, this time devoted to Alan Paton, is at present with the printers.

The local government issue, for instance, was largely built around a conference on the subject which had been held at Rhodes.
