Dear Sir,

I reside on Rem. of 4 of Montrose along the back boundary of which is being built the new link road between Old Howick Rd and the subway at the Pietermaritzburg Country Club.

I refer to earlier correspondence with you and in particular my letter of 7th July, 1973 (CE: 2/32/2) in which I expressed my concern about the disposal of drainage water from the new road. Subsequently I was visited by representatives of the consulting engineers concerned with the contract and they were of the view that there should be no threat to my property from water draining from the road.

Now that the road is almost completed it seems that all water collected between Howick Rd and an old water-course behind my property, as well as some between the water-course and the country club will be collected into drain-pipes under the road which will then disgorge this water straight on to my property. As the flow of water is likely to be substantial and the damage to my property could be considerable I would be grateful if this matter could be investigated before the summer rains start.
