You are invited to attend a major two day conference on job creation to take place on the 18TH AND 19TH SEPTEMBER, 1980 at the University of Natal, Durban. The South African Sugar Association is sponsoring the Conference in association with the University of Natal, the Urban Foundation, the Institute of Race Relations and Human Awareness Programme. The opening session of the Conference will be chaired by Mr. C.J. Saunders and the invited speakers that evening are Dr. Simon Brand and Chief Gatsha Buthelezi. Speakers at the Conference sessions include both Government and private sector representatives of mining, construction, agriculture, industry and commerce.
