Dear Si,

I think it will probably be best if I give you the background to the various educational problems with which I am going to burden you before I come to see you.

ISRAEL LETUMA:

Received the sum of R. 39 - 00 from me during 1961.

His mother died and he had to return home and missed his exams and must now repeat.

I am prepared to advance him R 60-00 during 1962 and I am prepared to pay his fees for 1963 (these would be 67 rands) provided he passes next year.

If he does not pass he should start paying back in 1963, if he does pass he should start paying back in 1964.

The rate of repayment will depend largely on whether he passes or not. If he does he may be able to afford 6 rands a month, if not it might only be 2 or 4.

Ernest Sibiya:

I am prepared to advance him 60 rands for his fees in 1962 on the same basis as the above. *in 1963 if he passes.*

I have suggested that both come and see you on January 6th.
