RE. BOARDING FEES 1962.

In view of the increasing costs connected with running all branches of the hostels at this school, the Department has been compelled to review the financial situation very carefully.

The decision reached is that as from the beginning of the second quarter 1962 the boarding fee for each boarder will be raised to R15-00 (R7.10.0) per quarter. That is, the boarding fee which falls due and must be paid on or before 15th March, 1962 (according to the lists sent with acceptance letters) will be R15-00 instead of R13-00, and the same amount R15-00 will have to be paid for every other quarter in future, unless you are advised differently by letter from this school.

It must be emphasised that this increase in fees is quite unavoidable and, even after the increase, the fees at this school still remain the lowest in the province for schools of a similar standard.

It must also be pointed out that the Advisory Board, subject to the approval of the Secretary for Bantu Education, may be obliged to review the situation again in the future with a view to altering the fees payable, although these would only be raised again as a last resort to prevent heavy loss in maintaining the standard of accommodation of fered.
