Dear Peter,

Sorry to delay replying to your letter of the 6th May. Thank you for discussing the problem with Edgar. I know it could not have been easy to write the letter. Perhaps it was even too late, because the voting papers were distributed shortly after I wrote to you, and it may be that the election will now have to proceed, whatever the result.

Regarding the law as to whether you may now be quoted since your ban has ended, I read in the paper the other day that the Suppression of Communism Act is to be amended by a General Law Amendment Act that will allow the quotation of statements made by persons who are no longer banned.
