

Notes: Interview with RANDOLPH VIGNE London 29 Feb.

Reluctant to talk. Is not prepared to dredge up "other people's activities". Is prepared to answer specific questions of fact if not affect other people.

He suggests that I focus more on political crimes. I agree with this and suggest closure agreement if he thinks this will protect others. He agrees to this.

He reacts strongly against my formulation of the why of sabotage; finds it 'academic' and psychologistic. He agrees with me on "need to put record straight" and state (cites popular notion of NCL as composed of students, notion of the failure as caused by arrogance as examples).

Suggests that Rubin, Leftwich should be contacted, and thinks De Crespigny = worth contacting. He also suggests I talk to John Lloyd & says he might try to find him, does not think he = entirely kosher. He also mentions that his papers are at SOAS and Berman's wife Myrtle. (Does not think Monty will talk.) Cox = dead.

We agree to meet when I have formulated specific questions.
