-In 1962 (at least) I believe you were working full time for the LP a R 100 per month + supplies.

-Did Lang pay for this and how much would it have been in total?

I'm pretty sure it was D & A money, disbursed to the LP during Lang's brief tenure there. It funded my Transkei toing and froing. I have, I'm afraid, absolutely no idea how much it was. Certainly not enough. I was earning by writing too - mainly a huge commemorative book on Cape Town and much editorial work, indexing etc. for Julian Rollnick's printing firm. Maskew Miller and I parted - amicably enough - after the emergency in 1960, after they SB heavies had leant on the chairman, H C Miller.

Alson Ernie W in his memoirs says that the LP or perhaps the Transvaal LP got money from JL--did you come across this in your research and how much was it in total.

Again, this was D & A money. I'm pretty sure. Herbststein mentions this in his MS history of D & A / IDAF, which I'm reading at present. I'll look it up. Probably impossible questions but I need to ask
