Paton's poignant memories make up a love letter to his wife, a remarkable woman who died after a long illness. During the course of this vital memorial, the world-famous author of "Cry the Beloved Country" traces and interweaves the elements both of his marriage and his varied career. Originally a teacher, Paton headed the Diepkloof Reformatory for boys near Johannesburg, South Africa—a humanizing experience which led to his later involvement with the Liberal Association of South Africa, which became in time a political party. But more central to these memoirs is the inner story of Paton's marriage—an honest confession describing the breaking down of barriers between him and his wife, a fleeting episode with another woman, the advent of fame, then his wife's mortal illness, faith tested and renewed. *Major national advertising.*
