



OUR CHAPEL ISN'T BIG ENOUGH

AT MINDOLO we are training leaders for service in the new nations of Africa. Every day this year at Mindolo some 120 students will be learning banking, child care, farming, journalism, youth work, management, homecraft.

These are the skills African nations need urgently, and at Mindolo we teach them in the name of Jesus Christ, who wants people to share his abundant life. We are grateful that we have qualified staff, teaching equipment, classrooms. Only our chapel isn't big enough.

We asked in 1964 for help in building a new chapel and help came, but not enough. We have

been giving steadily ourselves and the fund now stands at 4,000 Kwacha (about £2,300 sterling, \$5,600 U.S.) Building costs have risen steeply in Zambia and we have decided that we ought to use the money to enlarge our present chapel instead of building a new one.

Our architect has planned an extension which will be both practical and beautiful. To build and furnish it will cost an extra 5,000 Kwacha above what we have. We have pledged ourselves to raise over half this extra amount within Africa. We ask that friends outside Africa will help us with the rest, so that this year all 120 of us can worship under one roof.
