The book on Clayton is now finished, but it still has to be read by two people: Bishop Cowdry, and Beyers Naudé, the latter to make sure that I am not unjust to the D.R.C.s. Would it be possible to find out the number of priests, the number of women workers, and the number of church schools in the diocese of Johannesburg when Clayton became bishop in 1934?
