I have finished the life of Geoffrey Clayton, who was Bishop of Johannesburg and then Archbishop. There is one gap that I hope you will be able to fill for me. In 1936 the Inter-Departmental Committee on Native Education made certain proposals. Although this Committee figures in the Handbook of Race Relations, on pages 365, 369 and 370, it is nowhere stated what the proposals were. I cannot find them in Eric Walker or the O.U.P.
