Dear Alan,

I am writing to you now at the request of Harold Boxall, who would like to know to which Bank you want us to send the monies which are due to you at this moment from "Cry The Beloved Country" on account of your 2% participation.

It is impossible, as suggested by your Agent, to send this money to America, neither can Jupiter Films pay it there as the income of a film in America amounts to practically nothing and, the Bank of England will not give a permit for incomes from other countries to be transferred to the United States. I hope you have no objection to this arrangement, but anyway we are unable to manage it in any other manner and I think you will find it almost the same to get this money in South Africa as in the United States.

I will also write a private letter to you very soon, but perhaps you will send the reply to this one direct to Harold Boxall, London Film Productions, 146, Piccadilly, London, W.1.

Would you kindly notify your agent in America of this arrangement. I believe at the moment there is about £512. due to you and I expect with some luck you will get a further £750. but this of course will take some time.
