I have been approached by the South African Institute of Race Relations asking whether it would be able to have the premieres of CRY THE BELOVED COUNTRY in Capetown and Johannesburg. I cannot think of any organisation which would be more deserving of this if it could be arranged.

In Durban some friends of mine are starting a settlement for tuberculous Africans, and if it were possible, I should be glad for them to have the premiere in Durban. Would you please tell me of other steps I should take besides writing to you about it.

I might mention that Miss Neale, the financial organiser of the Institute of Race Relations will be going to England in August. Should she come to see you personally about the Capetown and Johannesburg premieres? I am sure that such a start for the film in these three centres would be to everyone's advantage.
