Thank you for your letter of the 29th September. I am so sorry that my letter to you took so long in reaching you. I note the name of your Bankers, and I have accordingly made application for the amount to be sent to you forthwith.

With regard to Miss Annie Laurie Williams and the payment of her commission, the Bank of England refused us permission to pay her dollars and it was for this reason that she suggested that you should get permission from South Africa to send the money to her. As, however, you already have dollars in America I do not think that there should be any reason why you could not pay the commission direct. It depends, though, upon the regulations of South Africa and no doubt your Bank could advise you as to this point.
