Re Visit to India

Extract from letter to Sir Raza Ali, dated 9th July, 1936.



..... There is one thing that I want to ask you to do for me in connection with my visit. I find that there are quite a number of my friends and contemporaries of Oxford days who are in India, and if it is at all possible I would like to meet them during my visit. I am taking the liberty of enclosing herewith a list of their names and their most recent addresses that I have available. Do you think it would be possible for inquiries to be made in India as to their present whereabouts, and for them to be told of my visit so that, where it fits in with the itinerary, I could meet them, even if it is only for a few minutes?

Extract from letter written to Sir Raza Ali, dated 24th July, 1936.

.....I am glad that Mr. Hydari will be in charge of the delegation while in India. We were contemporaries at Oxford, and I knew him very well.
