Dear Mr. Paton,

I have at last succeeded in obtaining the information you wanted about Dr. G.S. Corstorphine.

In June, 1918, he informed the Council that his doctors prescribed a long rest and he was granted prolonged leave of absence while Professor A. Ogg was appointed Acting Principal. Dr. Corstorphine died at Cape Town on 24th January, 1919 and Professor Ogg continued to act as Vice-Principal until 28th February, 1919. Mr. J.H. Hofmeyr became Principal on 1st March, 1919.
