Dear Professor Lindfors:

Here is a quick note, first, to indicate that I am back in Ghana and back at work with a mountain load of stuff waiting to be cleared. I have given your letter requesting a contribution on Kojo Laing to Prof. Kropp-Dakubu. I met with her a couple of days ago and briefed her further about the DLB project. She has agreed to work on the entry and assured me that she will get in touch with you soon. She has already sent a note to Kojo Laing himself requesting his cooperation on the project. We expect that Kojo will be willing to provide whatever information she might require from him personally.

Concerning the entry on my work, I now have an address for my colleague Dannabang in Canada, but I'm not too sure we should burden him with this particular request, considering that he must be spending the next several months trying to adjust to his new environment and to the various demands on his time as a beginning doctoral student.
