Well here I am if the Govt, will let me stay - if not I shall pack my bags & move on. The **UKZN Gandhi Institute for Documentation Centre** promised has folded up - & though a number of promises have been made - I wait hopefully.

The vegetation here is lush in the extreme - like Berman bush, Mangoes & Avocados abound. I live in a hut with mosquitos & lizards - its certainly a change - all manner of trees & flowers - I can see why you like it.
