Yours found me in perfect health. I wish this one will find you in just as good a condition. Winter has set in here, though we have every reason to be thankful that so far it has had no adverse effects. Rain is scarce. Wind is scarce. Only cold is promising to be our companion in the next few months.

So Sidney Poitier is still in the film scene! He's a good actor. I wonder what the theme of the film he is acting in is! I was very much interested in what you would have to say about dancing. There wasn't very much in this, your last letter. I would be pleased if you would give me some news thereon.

I am improving my Afrikaans this end. I intend to register in October if all goes well. I still have to apply for permission

to study. The degree I wish to study is done on a three year or a four year period. I shall take mine on a four year period because of financial reasons. This year I have just about enough for tuition. Taking four courses I have to pay R10.00 registration fees, and R30.00 for each course I will study. I shall take four courses. I have the amount but will lack only money for text books and stationery. I calculate it to be R50.00. I would thus be very pleased if you can be organising it in the mean while.

How is your Soccer club doing. Mine has come up to occupy 4th position in the league that we completed about two weeks ago. We left five clubs behind us including Steves. Greet Albert and wife for me. Tell him that Kufile has passed his Senior Certificate and is lazing this year. Remain.
