I am now here in Lusaka and the comrades want me to be based here. I wanted to go back to Botswana - no dice. Andrew is here for a short visit but will soon be moving. He is not based anywhere, so he is all over. He says I must give you his best regards. He says I all the children are fine. They are at school. Any news of your children? Where are they? Are they in London? Give them my regards when you write to them. How is Lesotho? Please write dear P.T.O.

Keep in touch with me. Maaxa I am writing
this letter being so tired am from work
and my hands are so full - too much
work to be done.
