Dear Phyllis,

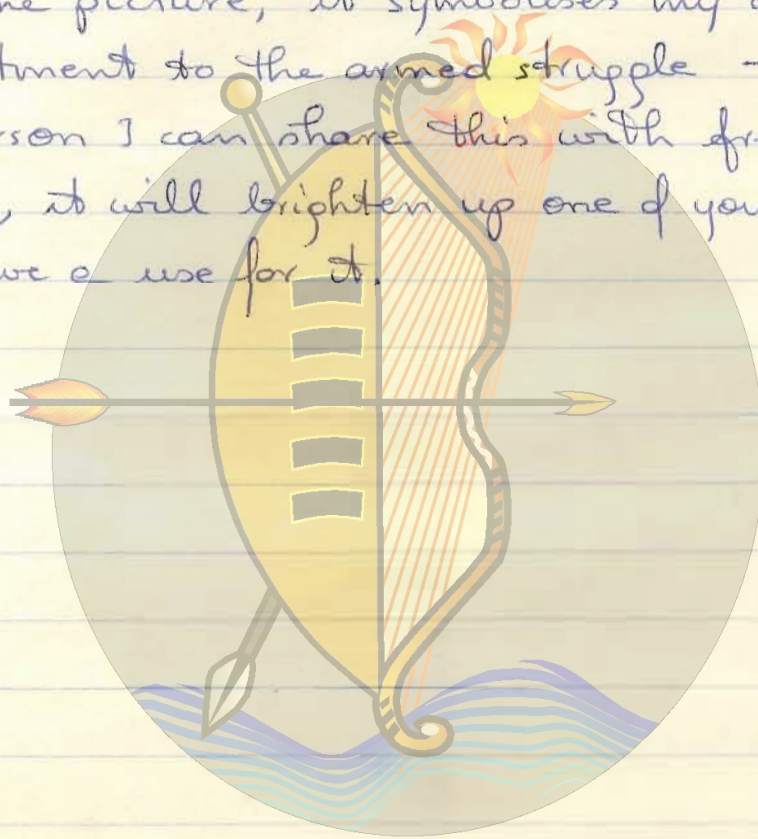
Here is a Chimurenga poster - I want you
