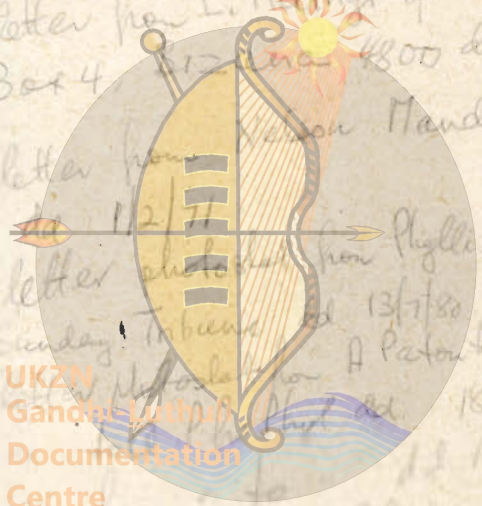

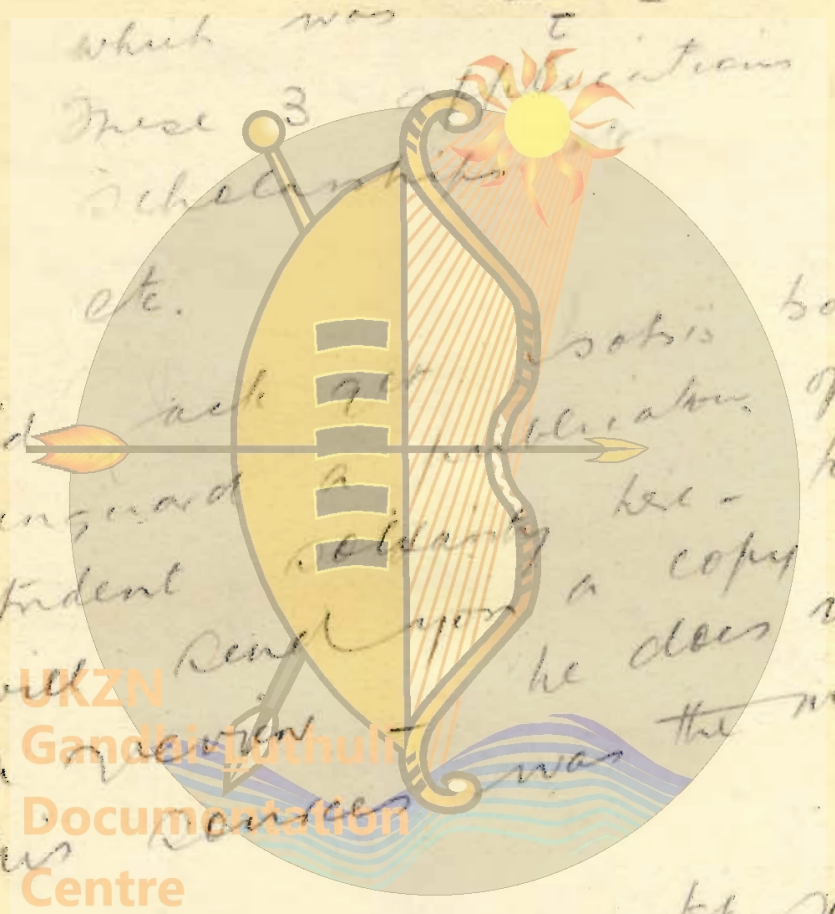
6. I have a box into which I put material for you - you can tell me if they are useful to you or to others.

(c) These 3 publications for Schellings etc.

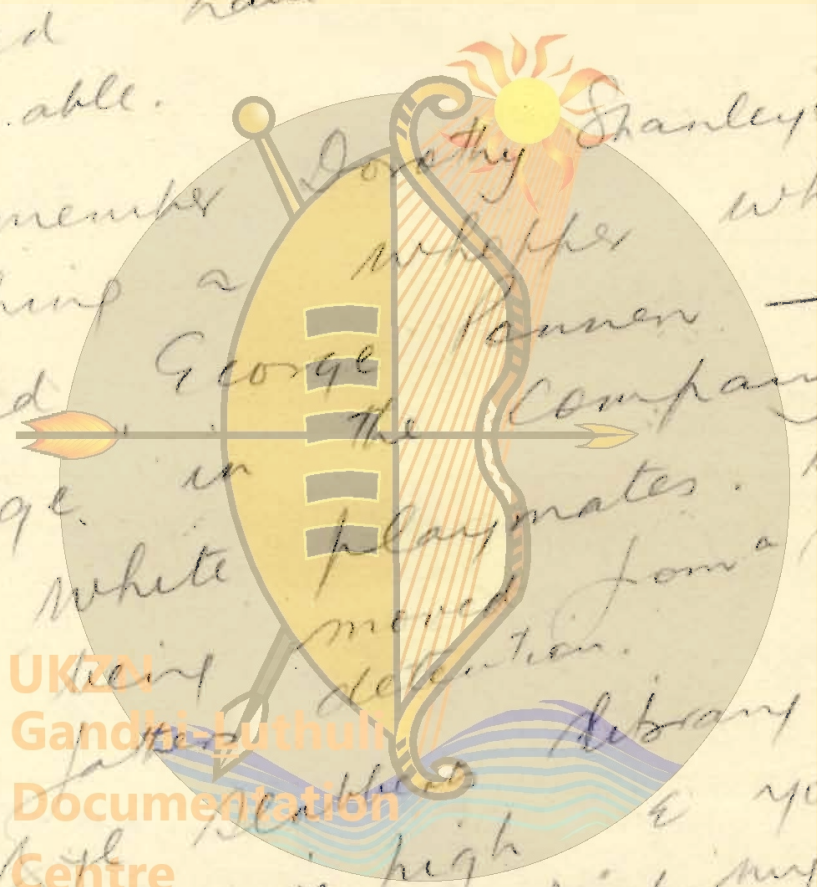
7. Did not get book - Vanguard a publication of CASAS. Student body - hopefully will send you a copy - have done a review he does not acknowledge his sources was the main complaint?

Please give me a list of things you require - I don't be shy about it - the least phrase is an order - my friend.

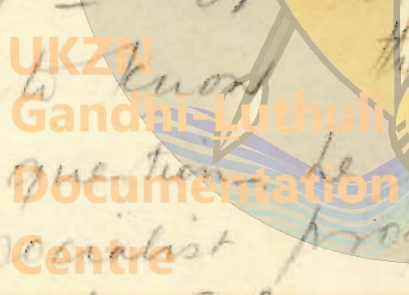
