Dear Phyllis!

Thank you very much for your letter and the receipt. Our course is finished now. I have just moved from Berlin to Mainz and I will now live together with my girl-friend. Perhaps I will get a job in Frankfurt.

At the moment I am visiting my parents. Jürgen is likely to get a job in Frankfurt too, but he does not know whether he shall leave Berlin.

You wrote me that your daughter came back. What will she do now? Give her, Renato and Mrs. and Mr. Jackson my kind regards. How did the protest action in Masereu against the murder of Neil Oggett come off?

My girl-friend and I took part in an anti-apartheid-action at the International Tourism Fair in Berlin at the beginning of March. We protested against the South Africa-stand. The German police thrashed some of ~~the~~ us, arrested us for one and an half hour and now we (15 people) are facing a trial because of violation of privacy. You can imagine our anger. It is really a bitter experience to see that the rassist are de facto supported by German police and administration of justice. We hope that we will be able to turn the whole thing with

the help of the German Anti-Apartheid-Movement.
What is going on in Lesotho and especially
in South Africa. Perhaps you can send me
some information / some cuttings.

I send you this letter through Michael
because I think it is more secure.
