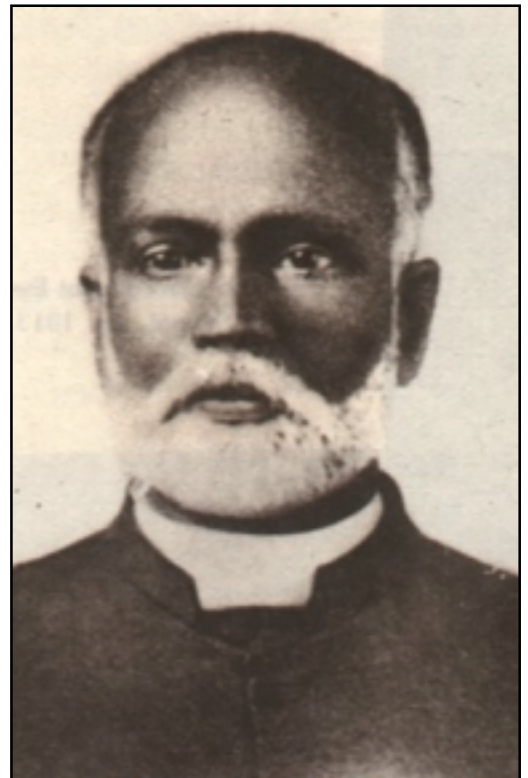


Image 9: Veerasawamy Mudeliar, Chief Interpreter of the Immigration Department of the Guyana Government.
