re: Indian Penetration : Deputation to meet
the Hon. the Minister of Interior.

"Re deputation to meet Minister re Indian Penetration STOP Are you in position to inform me whether and if so when Minister will be able to receive deputation from Durban City Council mentioned in my previous telegram and letter STOP A report published in Natal Mercury this morning names probable personnel of proposed Advisory Committee can you inform me whether Minister has made any appointments in this connection or taken any final decisions".

I have this morning received the following telegram from the Secretary of the Interior in reply :-

"Re your telegram 19th November and previous correspondence STOP Minister prepared meet deputation first December 11.30 a.m. STOP Decision to appoint Asiatic Advisory Committee taken but no appointments yet made".
