

HOW CAN WE FORGET?

- ⇒ The forced removals from **Cato Manor** and **Riverside**
- ⇒ Apartheid's **affirmative action** policies
 - **best beaches** and **parks** reserved for whites
 - **schools, hospitals** and **police stations** serving whites received more money and resources than those in the other communities
 - **top jobs** were reserved for whites
 - whites were paid a **higher salary** for the same job compared to people of colour
 - the Durban corporation paid little attention to the development of Kenville / Greenwood Park areas yet the residents of these areas paid **higher rates** than the residents of Durban North and Umhlanga
- ⇒ The use of **puppet leaders**, against the will of the people, in the **Tricameral parliament** to further oppress the Indian and Coloured Peoples

This was apartheid as practised by the NATIONAL PARTY as head of the National Government and the UNITED PARTY (NOW DEMOCRATIC PARTY) as Local Government in charge of the NATAL PROVINCIAL ADMINISTRATION and DURBAN CORPORATION.

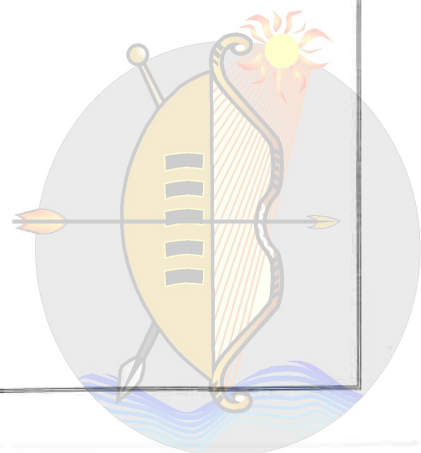
After 40 years of their rule how did it benefit ALL of us ? They were an illegitimate and undemocratic government that benefited a **minority** !

FREEDOM CHARTER

Preamble

We, the people of South Africa, declare for all our country and the world to know:
That South Africa belongs to all who live in it, black and white, and that no government can justly claim authority unless it is based on the will of the people;
That our people have been robbed of their birthright to land, liberty and peace by a form of government founded on injustice and inequality;
That our country will never be prosperous or free until all our people live in brotherhood, enjoying equal rights and opportunities;
That only a democratic state, based on the will of all the people, can secure to all their birthright without distinction of colour, race, sex or belief;
And therefore, we the people of South Africa, black and white, together - equals, countrymen and brothers - adopt this Freedom Charter; and we pledge ourselves to strive together, sparing nothing of our strength and courage, until the democratic changes here set out have been won.

The People Shall Govern!

Every man and woman shall have the right to vote for and stand as a candidate for all bodies which makes laws

All National Groups Shall Have Equal Rights!

All people shall have equal rights to use their own language and to develop their own folk culture and customs

The People Shall Share In The Country's Wealth!

All people shall have equal rights to trade where they choose, to manufacture and to enter all trades, crafts and professions

The Land Shall Be Shared Among Those Who Work It!

All shall have the right to occupy land wherever they choose

All Shall Be Equal Before The Law!

The courts shall be representatives of all the people

All Shall Enjoy Equal Human Rights!

The laws shall guarantee to all the right to speak, to organize, to meet together, to publish, to worship and to educate their children

There Shall Be Work And Security!

Men and women of all races shall receive equal pay for equal work

The Doors Of Learning And Of Culture Shall Be Opened!

The aim of education shall be to teach to love their people and their culture, to honour human brotherhood, liberty and peace

There Shall Be Houses, Security And Comfort!

All people shall have the right to live where they choose, to be decently housed, and to bring up their families in comfort and security

There Shall Be Peace And Friendship!

South Africa shall strive to maintain world peace and the settlement of all international disputes by negotiation – not war

Let all who love their people and their country now say, as we say here:
**'THESE FREEDOMS WE WILL FIGHT FOR, SIDE BY SIDE THROUGHOUT OUR LIVES,
UNTIL WE HAVE WON OUR LIBERTY.'**

Adopted at the Congress of the People, at Kliptown, on June 25-26, 1955
