

# Maximum Prices of Sugar

## Government Notice No. 2729, 3 November 1950

In terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Frederick Viljoen Ashpole, Price Controller, hereby—

- (1) amend Government Notice No. 1713 of 20th July, 1950 (Maximum Prices of Groceries), by the substitution of the item in the Fourth Schedule hereto for the corresponding item in the Fourth Schedule thereto; and
- (2) withdraw Government Notice No. 2358 of 22nd September, 1950 (Maximum Prices of Icing Sugar and Castor Sugar).

### Fourth Schedule

Item No. 16—Sugar.

The provisions of paragraph 7 of the First Schedule shall not apply to the calculation of the maximum price of any quantity of sugar, but any fraction of a farthing in any such price shall be regarded as a farthing.

#### No. 2 Grade ("Government") Sugar

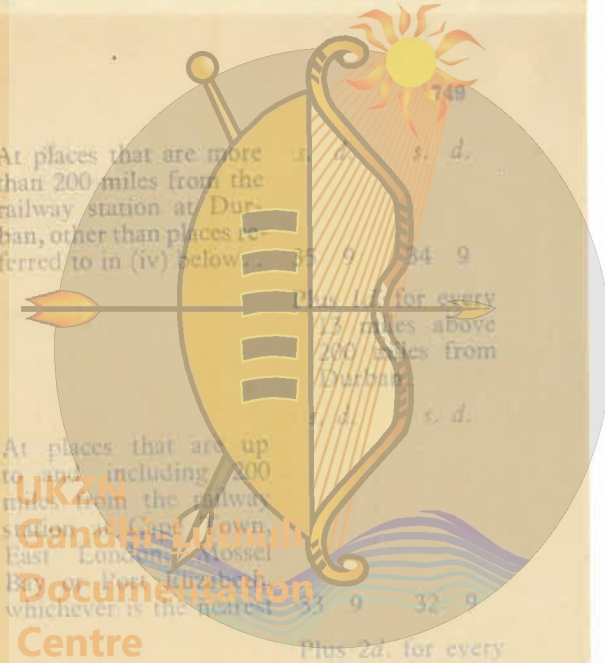

Plus 2d. for every 13 miles from the railway station at Cape Town, East London, Mossel Bay or Port Elizabeth, whichever is the nearest. . . . . s. d. s. d.

(iv) At places that are more than 200 miles from the railway station at Cape Town, East London, Mossel Bay, or Port Elizabeth, whichever is the nearest, provided that if any such place is nearer to Durban than to Cape Town, East London, Mossel Bay or Port Elizabeth, sub-paragraph (ii) above shall apply. . . . . 36 4 35 4

Plus 1d. for every 13 miles above 200 miles from the railway station at Cape Town, East London, Mossel Bay, or Port Elizabeth, whichever is the nearest.

Provided that at places that are more than five miles from the nearest railway station or siding in any of the areas referred to in 9 (d) above there may be added a further 6d. for the first ten miles or part thereof of the distance from such railway station or siding to such place and thereafter 3d. for every additional ten miles or part thereof of such distance.
