Appointment of Representatives to serve
on Sub-Committee re Indian Problem.

I have to refer to your letter of the 28th December, 1945 and previous correspondence relative to the above subject.

In reply I have to advise you that this matter received further consideration by the General Purpose Committee of the City Council at its meeting held on 22nd ultimo, when I was directed to inform you that there are still many questions and details to be discussed in connection with the Council's Post War Planning, and as the Council will appreciate the views of your Congress in this connection, the General Purposes Committee was of opinion that the round table conference referred to in my letter 24th December, 1946, should still be held.

Accordingly, I shall be glad to learn whether your Congress is prepared to meet the Council's Sub-Committee. If so, will you please furnish me with the names of your three representatives in order that arrangements may be made for a meeting of the Sub-Committee.
