Sch., promoted as headmaster of Mount Edgecombe Govt.-A. Ind. Sch. in 1937, transferred to Greytown in 1931, promoted to Port Shepstone Sch. in 1945; assumed principalship of Clairwood Indian

Junior Sch. and now known as the Durban South Primary Sch. in 1950. Public activities: Was hon. sec. and treas. of Lower Tugela Dist. Hindu V.D.S.; chairman of the N.I.T.S. Port Shepstone and Clairwood branches; chairman of the South Coast District Educational Board; played soccer, cricket and tennis; captained the first representative North Coast soccer team against Durban; captained the Stanger Tennis Club in Alfred David Shield matches.
