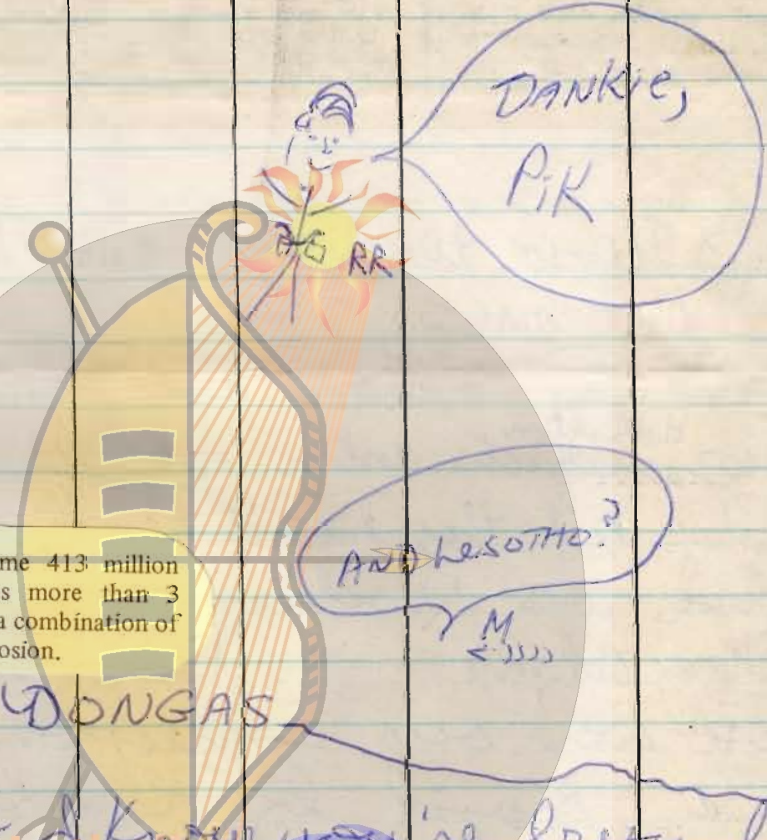

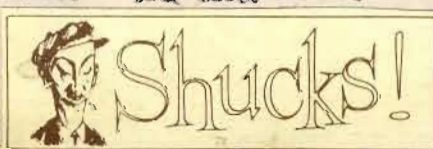
The U.S. farms some 413 million acres today, but loses more than 3 million acres a year to a combination of urbanization and soil erosion.
