Dorothee is alright, and she is improving, as far as eating and sleeping is concerned. Our life has become a little bit more stable. At nighttime, every other night each one of us is "on duty". That works quite well. All the time Dorothee is full of energy, crawling all over the place. Slowly she also learns to play for herself. Every day we go out for walks. It's lovely to see the flowering trees and meadows to walk in the nearby forest. My parents live in a lovely area.

Next week will go to West-Berlin for one week to visit my two sisters and their little daughters. In June, will also go to Bonn to meet Ingeborg and to join the big march which will be organized by the "peace movement" to welcome Reagan in West Germany.
