Dear Mrs Naidoo

Dame Edith Playel-Barritt has written to me from Geneva about the expulsion order that you have received from the Government of Lesotho, making it clear that you will not be allowed to return to Lesotho after your medical treatment here is finished.

Since I do not know exactly what your position is here I believe it would be best for you to contact an organisation skilled in dealing with refugee problems here and knowing about the immigration laws. After talking with you, of course in complete confidence, they would then write to me again if they felt it would be helpful to you.

I would therefore suggest that you contact either:

I hope that you will get in touch with either organisation, if you have not done so already, and that your position here can be secured.
