Appointment of Representatives to serve  
on Sub Committee re: Indian Problem.

I have to refer to your letter of 8th  
instant on the above subject.

In reply, I have to advise that your earlier  
letter dated 27th February, 1946, on the same subject  
was placed before the General Purposes Committee at its  
meeting held on 1st instant when I was directed to  
inform your Congress that it is proposed that the Sub-  
Committee re Indian Problem, as appointed by the City  
Council at its meeting held on 9th July, 1945, should  
remain in existence only for so long as both parties to  
the Sub-Committee wish it to continue and that the matters  
for discussion by the Sub-Committee are those approved  
at the aforementioned meeting of the City Council and  
as set out in my letter to you dated 11th July, 1945.

As regards the date of the initial meeting  
of the Sub-Committee this will be convened as soon as  
the necessary arrangements can be made to that end, of  
which you will be advised in due course.
