& check the time of the flight at 12 (Got in 10am)  
& I was saved. The ANC in these parts is  
handedled with Carl. Met all my beautiful  
friends - had drink out - ice-cream on the  
pavement - Left for Lusaka at 4.30am  
Did not sleep - Travelled with Mac - both of  
us fast asleep. Plane went to Bliva - Plane  
very hot & then to Lusaka. Formalities took  
some time - ANC had to clear some of us.  
Met one ANC guy who dressed like a Nigerian  
Got past customs in the UK. & got a

British firm came into the idea that he was buying agricultural equipment for his firm in Lusaka - all well documented.
