With reference to your report furnished on papers $\frac{2912}{1888}$ respecting certain observations made in the report of the Indian Immigrants Commission I am directed by the Governor to inform you that His Excellency observes by the report of the ~~Asst~~ Surgeon of the Durban Central Gaol that Gaol Regulation No 13 which requires that "every prisoner shall, as soon as possible after his admission, be examined by the Medical Officer who shall record" is not observed as it should be. His Excellency directs that this Rule must be strictly carried out, and ~~desires~~ ^{must have} an assurance from your Head of the Department that this will be done
