from our garden. - Before this letter will read you it will be getting to the end

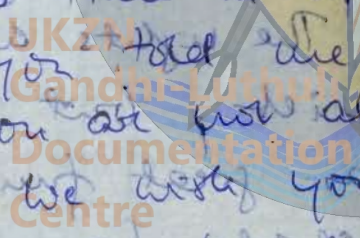
of your time in U.K. It was very sorry when you told me the loss of your brother, and you are not able to be with the
