Well, I have had my holiday in Morocco, & have enjoyed myself immensely. I only wish I could go straight back again! Sometime I will — I liked it so much I'll just have to see it again. I went with a group from London, & we had the greatest fun — we camped out, & generally "roughed it". It was such a novelty for me to be able to sleep outside in the open air in a sleeping bag. It would never be dry & hot enough in Ireland to do that! We visited Ceuta, Tangiers, Fez, Marrakech, Casablanca & Rabat. We also went
