I am glad your parcel arrived eventually -- I sent it to your former address as I posted it the day before I received your letter telling me of the change. I have been given some more things & will be sending 2 or 3 more in the next few days, and one will be to you. I sent the letter on to your friend Mrs Hardy.

So sorry about your divorce, but I can imagine that being separated by circumstances can have a disastrous effect on any marriage. I wish I could do more to help - there seems to be so much trouble in the world - Southern Africa, Middle East, Northern Ireland - sometimes I wonder where it will all end.

I have been particularly busy lately - since moving in October I have had to sort out all my property and goods from my Home at near Oxford. When my mother died in November she left the house to my brother and the cottage to me, and some furniture, so I have had to arrange to get all my movable property 'into Peterborough' so I could sort it all out, & thus I have been busy doing.

I have also had some difficulty at work - for some reason some of my work -

mates wrote a report which they had been asked to do, but it turned out to be a personal attack on me, & I have been busy hitting back and letting them know that if I am attacked, I can defend myself, and win. The doctor I work for is completely on my side and wants them to leave me alone to get on with my work in peace. The actual work I still enjoy very much indeed, and enjoy the company of the patients.
