He realizes, now, that not listening to his mother's advice and doing the reverse has landed him in trouble not only with wasted education, in wasting time with them but has dimmed his chances. get as many blacks to kill each other as possible, to renew their position in Guinea Bissau and take over again. A big case is coming up of a Swiss lawyer destined to become Lord Chief Justice who went to prison for 7 years innocent! My letter was also about that. More news later by God's grace. Much love
