Dear Mrs. Naidoo

To day I have to send you very sad news. Last wednesday Maria Floppenburg was suddenly taken from us. Monday - night they phoned in from the hospital, that she was admitted because of a heart attack. First it seemed to go better, but in the night her heart stood still for a few moments. The heart specialist put in a pace-maker, but although there was a little hope in the early morning, suddenly this was taken away, when at 10.30 a.m. death was inevitable.

She placed her dead body at disposal of the medical knowledge, so there was no funeral.

We write you, because Maria asked my husband to be the executor of her will, and we saw there was no "arriving date" on your letter. We thought it better to write you personally, before the funeral-cards are sent away. In a little box we found this lovely little photo. I know Maria was very fond of you and if ever necessary, you can write us.
