We travelled through Mocambique (where we had a terrific train ride - 60 hours on an overcrowded slow train to a closed Zimbabwe border) Zimbabwe, Zambia, and ended up in Dar-Es-Salaam at the end of August. It was a great experience to see a little from the young black states and compare to what we saw in South Africa. It was both inspiring and disillusioning (?) to see and I think a lot of questions are solved and my previous opinions are strengthened. I feel very well being home again - when you travel like we did you soon understand how much you like your boring daily life. Well this is a privilege for those who can afford travelling and whose daily life is nice and pleasant.....

We talked a lot about our common friend ^{in J.A.} when I saw you and I've delivered your greetings to our common friends in Sweden. They were really excited to hear from you. Maybe

you told me too much about our friend. I have to choose what to say - telling them all I've heard would be too hard. That's affects me in a way.....
