



DIPLOMA IN PRIMARY HEALTH CARE EDUCATION

The University of the Witwatersrand, Health Services Development Unit in conjunction with the Departments of Community Health and Nursing Education offer the Diploma in Primary Health Care Education.

Requirements:

- Matriculation Certificate and
- registration with SANC as a general nurse with a Diploma in Community Nursing Science or a Diploma in Clinical Nursing Science, Health Assessment, Treatment and Care or registration with the SAMDC or other relevant body and
- currently and actively training personnel in Primary Health Care.

Course Duration: Two (2) years part-time study, which includes 12-16 weeks of residential Blocks, spread over the two (2) years.

The course aims to provide education skills and a framework of understanding for the Primary Health Care educator/ trainer emphasising adult education and other relevant approaches.
