I DILIZA LENNOX LANDE do hereby make oath and say :-

1. THAT my nationality is South African, but I am presently residing in Lusaka, Zambia.
2. THAT I am a member of APDUSA and of the Unity Movement of South Africa.
3. THAT the members of the Head Unity Committee of the Unity Movement in Zambia decided to send four members to South Africa to revive the organisation in South Africa and to recruit people from South Africa for political training and military training abroad and it was left to the discretion of the four visiting South Africa as to which aspect they would place before any persons they approached.
4. THAT I was one of the four members who went to South Africa.
5. THAT in South Africa I spoke to many members of the Unity Movement and APDUSA during 1970, and to some I said that we were recruiting for military training while to others I mentioned only the aspect of political training omitting the question of military training.
6. THAT I am prepared to testify for the defence in the above case, but I will refuse to proceed to South Africa for that purpose.
7. THAT I am willing to testify on Commission in Zambia.
