3. **N S C CO-ORDINATORS**

4. **ROUTE TO NAMIBIA**

The route to Namibia to be used is JHB - Klerksdorp - Vryburg - Kuruman - Upington then SA/Namibia border Ariamsvlei into Namibia. The convoy/s will then proceed to KEETMANSHOOP, It is from this point that the combis and drivers will be sent to the various parts of Namibia.

5. **THE NAMIBIA SOLIDARITY COMMITTEE OFFICE IN NAMIBIA**

The NSC will set up a central office in Windhoek immediately after the arrival of the fleet. The office will be at the SWAPO H/Q and will have full-time functionaries for the 2 week period. Jackson Mthembu, Hazy Sibanyoni and Annelize will be among the full-time functionaries. The SWAPO H/Q phone number (i.e 016 38364) will be used to facilitate contact with the NSC and Cdes volunteering in Namibia.

6. **ACCOUNTABILITY IN NAMIBIA**

All volunteering comrades and drivers, whilst in Namibia, will be accountable and under the **command** of SWAPO. The NSC office will only act as a supervisor and co-ordinate the movements of the cars in consultation with SWAPO.

7. **MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE TRIP**

To assist SWAPO to register more than just a two thirds majority victory in the elections by transporting all SWAPO supporters to the polls.
