STUDENTS AND PARENTS OF SOwETO.

The Soweto Students Representative Council once more calls upon students and parents to react towards the takeover of community schools with immediate effect, taking into account the following aspects:-

1. Bantu Education will still be implemented and shall be regarded as the "last nail of the coffin".
2. Bantu Education is not compulsory to any Black child, but the government urges our parents to counter-sign forms which will make it their "Crime" if students happen to be dissatisfied with the administration of their education, alternatively, if arsonists decide to bombard schools property, our parents must pay for that kind of action.
3. A parent whose child absents himself or herself from school due to illness will have to account for his or her child's absence, failing which an immediate expulsion of his/her child from school, or the parent will be subject to court action!
4. The amount of money deducted from rent payments, that is claimed to be used to erect or improve schools, will still be deducted, but instead of having it used for the improvement of schools, it will be sent to the government for the following purposes:

- (a) Buy guns and ammunition to shoot the innocent students.
- (b) To facilitate attractive remuneration for police and soldiers, encouraging people to join the force thus converting our Azania to a PROPER POLICE STATE.
- (c) To frustrate students and people of Azania.
