


APPEAL TO ALL ANC (S.A.) GRADUATES ABROAD.

Dear Comrades,

- (1) We are appealing to you on a very urgent matter which needs your well-considered but quick response.
- (2) The ANC Information and Publicity Department is now two years old; and among its tasks is research into various spheres of the life of our people - historically, politically, economically, militarily etc. etc.
- (3) We are appealing to all ANC activists who shall soon be completing their M. Sc. or Ph. D. degrees in the above mentioned spheres to volunteer to join our ranks of full time Movement's research fellows (for no pay) at Headquarters, in Lusaka.
- (4) The submission of names of the volunteers shall pass through our normal communication channels with you i.e. through our students' organisation in your area or our office, where available.
- (5) Presently we have in our ranks and on full-time basis at HQ only comrades Dr Patrick Magapatona (formerly lecturer at the University of Dar-es-Salaam and University of Zambia) and Dr Zola Bona (fresh from the GDR). The latter, though still with us has now been appointed to head our office in Ethiopia. As you can see, our situation in this long over-due task is very bad.
- (6) We want specialists who are going to be think-tanks of the people's cause. We intend having sub-units of the Research Department composed of various committed ANC persons of various social and educational backgrounds to map out a common approach and tentative decisions on the present and future linking up all this exercise with home and international research on our problems.
- (7) Here is an opportunity therefore, for the intellectuals of our country and Movement to also demonstrate practically that they are part and parcel of our revolution, can sacrifice and make their own contribution to the general mass upsurge internally and abroad towards the seizure of people's power in our country. Our intellectuals too have a great role to play. Our revolution demands that our intellectuals analyze towards practical goals and thus help our leadership reach scientific decisions on day-to-day problems and in shaping our future. Even the quality of our literature will thus improve tremendously and help bring us closer to our goal.

In short, you are urgently invited to be part of our revolution, and luckily enough, in the field you have been trained and acquainted with.
