

A MESSAGE FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR-GENERAL OF NAMIBIA AND THE
SPECIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE
UNITED NATIONS TO ALL SWAPO PERSONNEL

1. Lay down your weapons and go back to Angola.
2. It is not necessary for you to come back to Namibia with weapons and perhaps die.
3. Resolution 435 says you must come back to Namibia peacefully without weapons and then you will be allowed to go back to your families and vote.
4. The people who told you to come back in uniform with heavy weapons have misled you. What they have told you to do has broken the agreements for peace reached by Angola, Cuba and South Africa and accepted by SWAPO.
5. You must rather return in peace and work for progress.
6. We guarantee that SWAPO members who lay down their arms in peace will be taken safely to points where UNTAG will take them to safe places in Angola.
7. SWAPO members can also move back north to Angola.
