My aim is to inform you about the Resolution passed by the above-named organisation's conference held at the University of Natal (Alan Taylor Residence) from the 4th-10th July, 1970.

The resolution is as follows:

RES.14/70:

That this G.S.C. noting:

- (i) That the University Christian Movement concerns itself with the practical application of Christian principles.
- (ii) That UCM undertakes practical projects like work-camps, literacy campaigns and similar projects aimed at alleviating the seriousness of conditions that come as a result of poverty and general deprivation.

instructs the Executive to maintain contact and to co-operate in practical and meaningful projects with UCM.
